Further down the coast is Jetwing’s Saffron and Blue, named for the fine sand and clear seas of its Kosgoda setting. measure. A strong Dutch influence is seen in the design of a verandah that wraps around the sleek plunge pool, creating warm open spaces that are perfect for relaxation in the tropical sun. A hammock hanging between the coconut palms of the lush garden or a beach chair as the waves rush to your feet, it is a treat for all the senses.
